School Catering

The extra outside benches we have purchased have provided even more outside seating. As a result, we insist that with the exception of water, there should be no eating or drinking in the school corridors. I would appreciate it if you would support us in this matter by encouraging your children to use the Steynton Hall and the outside seating when weather permits.

Along with all the other Pembrokeshire schools, we anticipate using a cashless system for the catering facilities after Easter. Further information will be issued to all parents and carers in due course.
